Actual Results	<p>Deliverable #1: Promotional activities to help inform producers about the MAWQCP in Stevens County included newsletter article in our November 2015 newsletter; informational article in our Annual Review, published as a special section in the March 5 Morris Sun Tribune; radio program spotlight on March 22; and a display board at the Spring Expo held in Morris March 18-19. Individual personal contacts were also made to landowners who have shown an interest in conservation programs in the past.</p> <p>Deliverable 2: Stevens SWCD staff member Kasey Wiechmann attended the Program and Assessment Tool Training on 6/9/16; although outside the grant period, this was the first training available to her. No grant funding from this \$6000 allocation was used to pay for this attendance.</p> <p>Deliverable 3: 10 producer contacts were made after initial promotion of the program, resulting in six actual applications. One of these applications includes a very large corporate producer with over 10,000 acres in production.</p> <p>Approximately 9-10% FTE. 178.25 hours worked at various billable rates (Wiechmann 55.25 hours @ \$32.93; Lembcke 84.50 hours @ \$35.22 and Erickson 39 hours @ \$35.37)</p>
