Actual Results	<p>850 hours total were spent in 2017 on buffer law implementation, including answering landowner questions and working on suggested map edits. A letter went to approximately 750 landowners to notify them of an informational meeting to be held January 30, 2017. The meeting was held to inform landowners about the new law and answer questions. Staff worked with landowners throughout the year to identify pieces needing buffers, develop conservation plans, and sign waivers where needed. Additional letters were sent to those not in compliance prior to the November 2017 deadline. Staff worked a total of 850 hours on these activities in 2017. A portion of these hours were funded by the 2016 grant and when those funds were exhausted, the remainder were funded by part the 2017 buffer grant allocation. As of 12/31/17, \$17228.82 in funding remains to be used in the coming year.</p> <p>Staff (including WCTSA) worked a total of 380.25 additional hours in 2018 on helping landowners with buffer compliance. This uses the remaining 2017 funding as of 12/31/18, although buffer compliance is an ongoing effort. Staff are communicating with landowners on a regular basis to assess compliance and notify landowners of their options for coming into compliance if they are not already.</p>
